LEARN TO SKATE GUIDELINES

Issued September 2018

1. Arrive early and give plenty of time to put on skates, tying them tightly.
2. Skate rentals are available at the pro shop for one dollar (\$1.00) per class. Hockey Skates may be worn thru Basic 3.
3. Helmets are required at all times for all snow plow level skaters.
4. Attendance is important in order to perform well in class.
5. No food, beverages or gum on the ice at any time.
6. No baggy pants may be worn during Learn to Skate lessons. All skater attire should be in "good taste".
7. Be respectful and courteous to MCFSC instructors, MCFSC helpers and other skaters.
8. Only registered Learn to Skate skaters and authorized instructors and authorized helpers may be on the ice during Learn to Skate classes. **No parents on the ice during lessons.**
9. All Learn to Skate skaters under the age of twelve (12) shall have a parent or designated adult guardian, other than a coach or instructor, on MCIC premises during the entire Learn to Skate lesson.
10. Failure to follow these rules will result in removal from the ice for the balance of the session.
